House Republicans Announce Their Campaign Team for 2022

Speaker of the House Jason Wentworth today announced a new campaign team for the House Republican caucus, led by new co-chairs Sarah Lightner and Greg VanWoerkom. The two co-chairs will work with the other 18 members of the committee to organize House Republican campaign activities and preparations in advance of the 2022 general election. House Republicans will be running in that election to hold majority for the 13th and 14th straight years.

Amber McCann, a longtime staffer for Senate Republicans and currently deputy chief of staff and spokesperson for Senate Majority Leader Mike Shirkey, has accepted a new position with the Department of Attorney General in a bombshell development that has stunned those around the Capitol.

Ms. McCann was spokesperson for the last three Senate Republican leaders – Mr. Shirkey, Arlan Meekhof and Randy Richardville.

Ms. McCann will serve as special projects director for Attorney General Dana Nessel and serve under the department's communications director Kelly Rossman-McKinney.

Air Force One Touches Down in Kalamazoo for President Joe Biden's Pfizer Vaccine Plant Visit

Air Force One, carrying President Joe Biden arrive at Kalamazoo/Battle Creek International Airport in Kalamazoo, Michigan, on Friday, Feb. 19, 2021. President Biden toured Pfizer's coronavirus vaccine manufacturing plant in Portage on Friday afternoon.

The visit comes following the U.S. Department on Health and Human Services' announcement of their plan to purchase an additional 100 million COVID-19 doses from the Portage based company as part of the nationwide effort to accelerate vaccine distribution.

Governor Granholm joined President Biden on the tour, greeted by, state Reps. Christine Morse, D-Texas Township, and Julie Rogers, D-Kalamazoo Township.

MDHHS Extends COVID Restrictions to March 29

Michigan's Department of Health and Human Services has extended the 25% capacity limit and 10 p.m. curfew for restaurants in the state. Current restrictions that remain in place include a 25% capacity limit and a 10 p.m. curfew for indoor dining in Michigan restaurants.
