## LEGISLATIVE NEWS

House Election Update:

Throughout the 2020 election cycle, Khoury Johnson & Leavitt will keep clients informed on candidates and results for the August Primary and November General Election. This years election will include the Michigan House of Representatives, U.S. Congress, one U.S. Senate seat, board positions for state universities, and two Michigan Supreme Court seats.

The entire 110 member House is up for election and will see 23 new State Representatives due to term limits. Currently, the House of Representatives is made of 58 republicans, 51 democrats, and 1 vacant seat.

The vacancy stems from the passing of Representative Isaac Robinson (D-4) on March 29th, 2020 due to suspected COVID-19 related complications. A special election will be held concurrently with the August Primary and November general election for a representative to be seated for the remainder of the term.

This primary election cycle is marked by two key components. First, the COVID-19 pandemic has disrupted normal campaign activities including door knocking, fund raising, and general community activities across all potential candidates. Secondly, with a large number of presumptively returning caucus members, both parties have selected leaders for the next legislative session. Republican Jason Wentworth, District 97 and Donna Lasinski, District 52 have the support of their respective caucuses, a change of pace from previous years when primary elections could swing the balance of power within a party when factions back different candidates.

This is also the last election under the 2010 census legislative districts. The ballot initiative passed in 2018 requires that the district lines for 2022 are redrawn by a bi-partisan redistributing commission.

Attached is the candidate listing for the August 2020 primary election for the Michigan House of Representatives. Incumbents are annotated with the number of terms they have served. State Representatives are limited to (3) 2-year terms. Only candidates from the two majorities are listed for the purposes of the primary election.
